- Urgent needs include shelter, clean water and sanitation, food, blankets and mosquito nets.
- Schools reopened with 50% normal attendance on first day.
- Relief efforts coordinated by Government ministries in partnership with UN, Kenya Red Cross and NGO community.

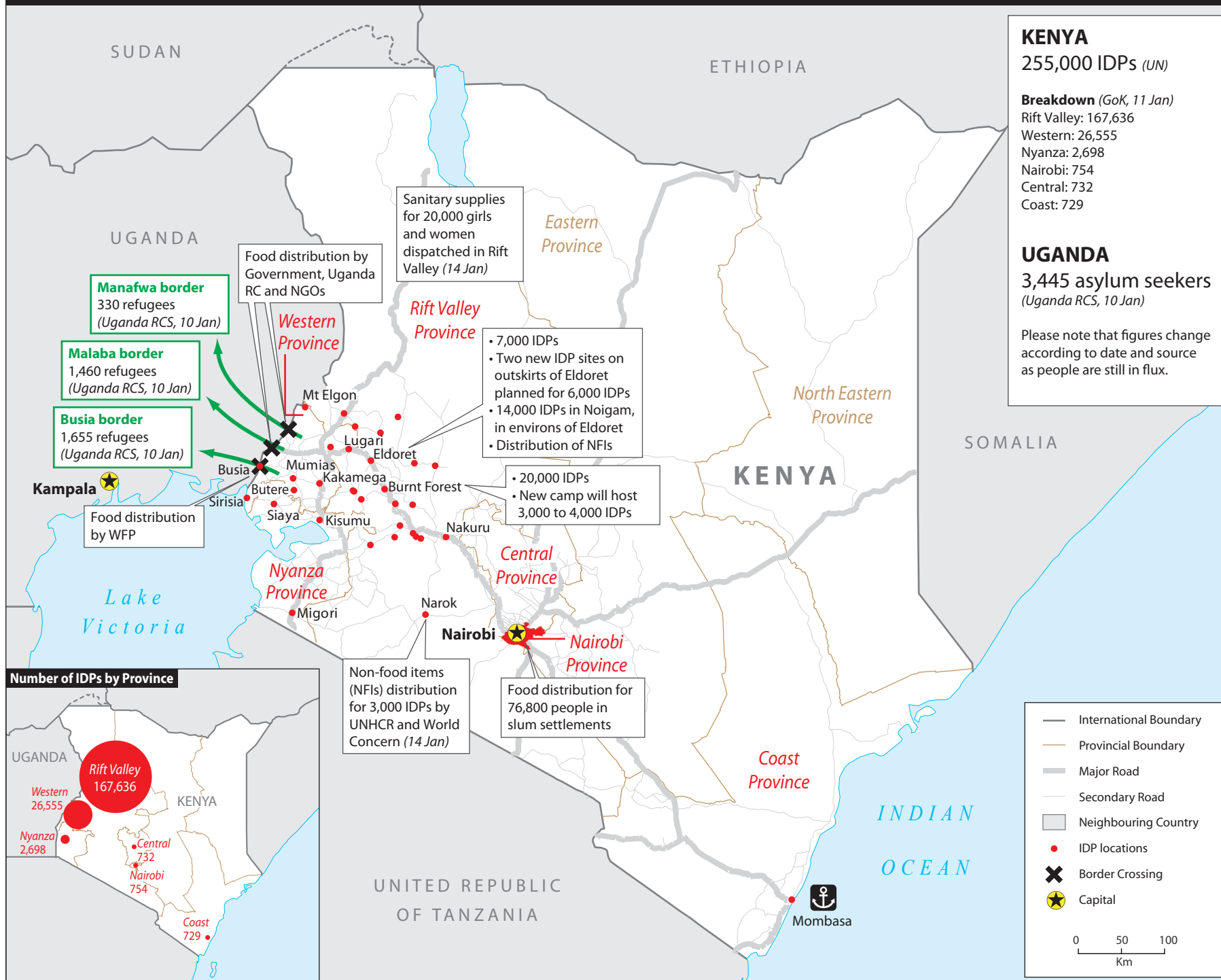
