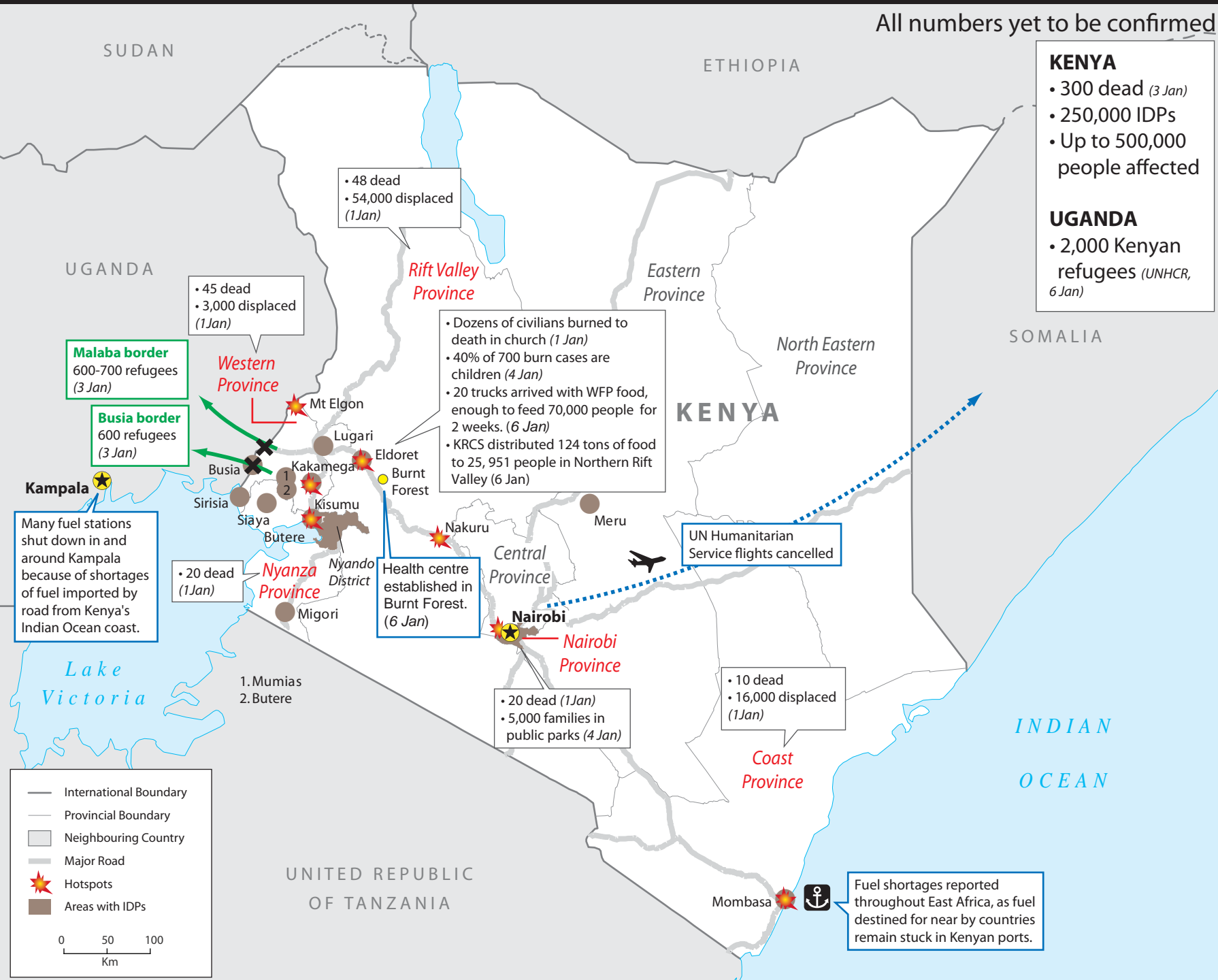


Kenya: Presidential Elections Violence (as of 6 Jan 2008)

KENYA

- 300 dead (3 Jan)
- 250,000 IDPs
- Up to 500,000 people affected

UGANDA

- 2,000 Kenyan refugees (UNHCR, 6 Jan)

- SITUATION**
- The security situation in Kenya continues to remain calm but tense.
 - Curfew lifted in Kisumu and Eldoret and Nairobi continuing to move towards normalcy.
 - Access to Eldoret has improved and food from WFP for 70,000 people arrives.
 - In addition to addressing immediate humanitarian needs, early recovery, reconstruction, rehabilitation and reconciliation efforts must also be considered.
