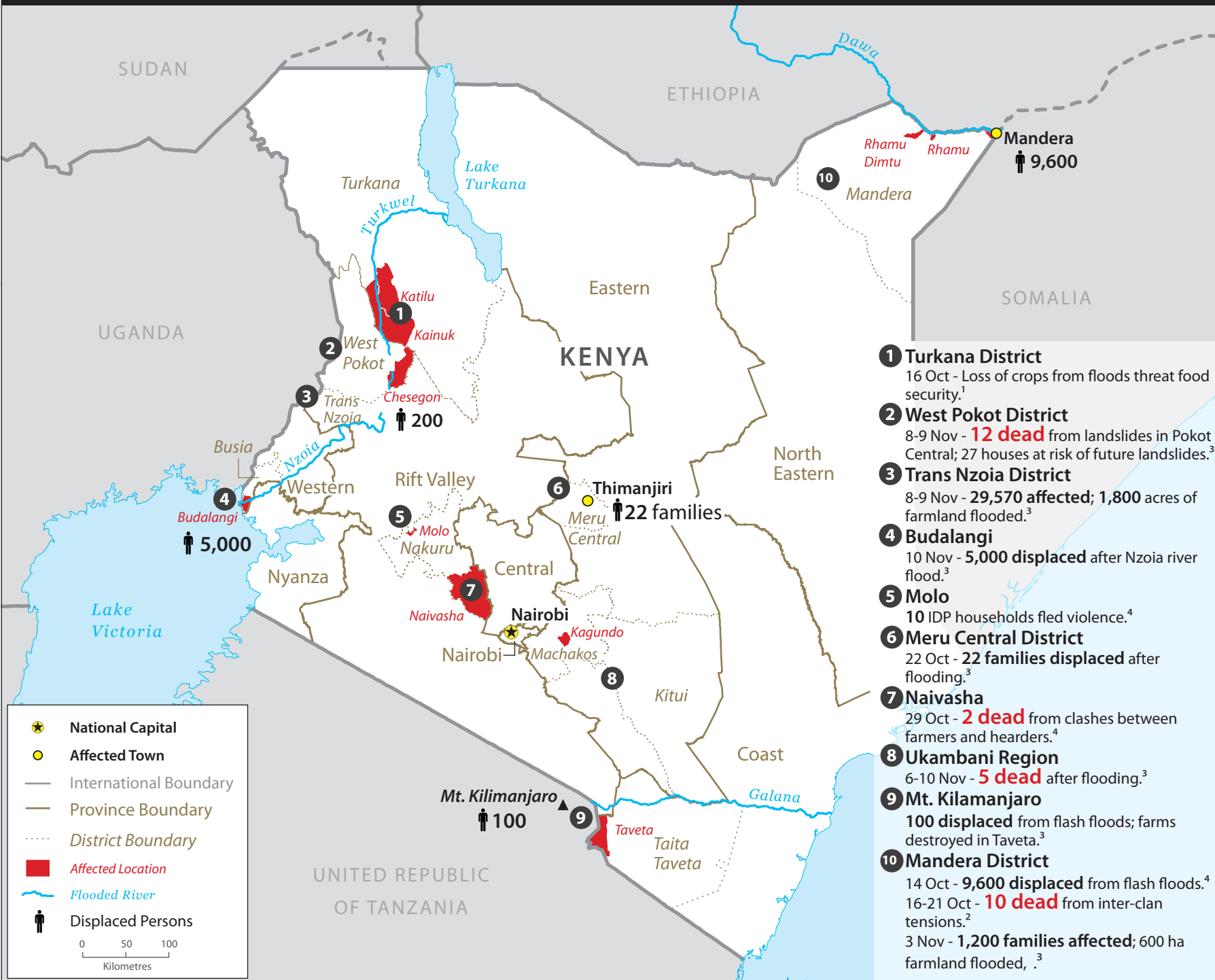


KENYA: Floods (as of 12 Nov 2008)

300,000 affected in Kenya³

- Intensive rains in Kenya in Oct and Nov have caused flooding, landslides and damage to farmland
- Displacement from flooding have escalated inter-clan tensions
- Humanitarian response in Mandera hindered by insecurity

- 1 Turkana District**
16 Oct - Loss of crops from floods threat food security.¹
- 2 West Pokot District**
8-9 Nov - **12 dead** from landslides in Pokot Central; 27 houses at risk of future landslides.³
- 3 Trans Nzoia District**
8-9 Nov - **29,570 affected**; **1,800 acres** of farmland flooded.³
- 4 Budalangi**
10 Nov - **5,000 displaced** after Nzoia river flood.³
- 5 Molo**
10 IDP households fled violence.⁴
- 6 Meru Central District**
22 Oct - **22 families displaced** after flooding.³
- 7 Naivasha**
29 Oct - **2 dead** from clashes between farmers and herders.⁴
- 8 Ukambani Region**
6-10 Nov - **5 dead** after flooding.³
- 9 Mt. Kilimanjaro**
100 displaced from flash floods; farms destroyed in Taveta.³
- 10 Mandera District**
14 Oct - **9,600 displaced** from flash floods.⁴
16-21 Oct - **10 dead** from inter-clan tensions.²
3 Nov - **1,200 families affected**; 600 ha farmland flooded.³
